We have identified a bug in our code which affects the inter-layer similarity measurement based on the linear CKA method. Specifically, the matrix of representations from each layer was errantly transposed prior to being input to the linear CKA function. After the transpose is corrected, we could not show that statistically significant correlations exist between name frequency and inter-layer similarity in the contextualizing language models studied.
