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Rhetorical Questions in Social Media

Motivation

- Rhetorical Questions (RQs) are a type of figurative language aimed at achieving some pragmatic goal
- Many uses are sarcastic, but there are other uses (Ilie '94, Schaffer '05)
- We note use of argumentation in forums and persuasion in tweets

	Forums	Twitter
Sarc	If they haven't been discovered yet, HOW THE BLOODY HELL DO YOU KNOW? Ten percent more brains and you'd be pond life.	You know what's the best? Unreliable friends. They're so much fun. #sarcasm #whatever
Other	How is that related to deterrence? Once again, deterrence is preventing through fear of consequences.	Craft ladies, salon owners, party planners? You need to state your #business [link]

Corpus Creation

- We use data from the Internet Argument Corpus for debate (Walker et al. '12), and Twitter
- We develop a "middle-of-post" heuristic to gather data:
- Speaker asks a question, then continues their turn
 - 75% of these are found to be RQs
- We end up with a large, novel set of RQs in forums and Twitter:

RQs in Forums	2,496
RQs in Tweets	7,774

Identifying RQs and their Uses

RQs vs Information-Seeking Qs

• We look for "information-seeking" questions in the IAC, labeled "factual" (Oraby et al. '15):

If someone is an an attorney or in law enforcement, would you please give an interpretation?

- We create a small dataset of ~1K of each class (RQ vs Information-seeking)
- We experiment with simple W2V features on SVM (80/20 train/test)

• We classify sarcastic/other uses of RQs in forums and Twitter with different levels of context in training, and embedding/LIWC features

Linguistic Analysis of Sarcastic and Other Uses of RQs

The Effect of Context

• Forums posts are more sensitive to changes in context due to length

	Forums	Twitter
	RQ + Post	<u>Full Tweet</u>
Sarc	Does the pacific ocean truly 'exist'? oh yeah 3000! time to celebrate!	Gasp! Two football players got into it with each other?! How uncivilized! Lets make a big deal about it! #NFLlogic #cowboys
	Pre + RQ	<u>Full Tweet</u>
Other	'Know it all'? I simply see what is negative, stupid, bad, etc., and what is not. Can you say the same about yourself? of course you can, but will it also be valid? Doubtful.	Are you willing to succeed? The answer isn't as simple as you may think. Read my blog post and you'll see why [link]

Linguistic Features

We analyze the most discriminative LIWC features by class and domain

Forums	
2nd Person	Do you ever read headers? You got a mouth on you as big as the grand canyon.
Informal	The hate you're spewing is palpable, yet you can't even see that can you? Hypocrites ya gotta luv em.
Interrogatives	How do you know it's the truth? If it were definitive []
Quantifiers	[] we have minimum wage, why can't we have maximum wage? So of []
Twitter	
Comma	Wait, wait I can't it's impossible NO WAY?! - a stiffer track pad?!

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3rd Person Plural	How intelligent, they make the laws and then violate [them]? That is absurd!
Swear Words	Idk why I'm fighting my sleep?! Aint s*** else to do
Friends	Can I get 12.7K followers today? :) xo Thanks to everyone who is following me.
