Using LogosClient<sup>™</sup> the user can send and receive texts to and from the translation engine without leaving her or his desktop publishing or word processing environment on either a PC or UNIX platform. Logos is fully integrated with several translation memory packages to provide the fullest possible support of customers' needs.
