

# Hybridization: Pre-AMTA 2006

- Preprocessing:
  - Morphology, NE's → any MT method
  - Reordering rules → EBMT, SMT, CBMT
- Postprocessing:
  - Any set of MT methods → MEMT
- Integrated:
  - SMT + EBMT (phrase tables, decoders)  $\approx$  SMT<sup>++</sup>
  - Syntax “SMT” (e.g. ISI, UMD, ...)

# Hybridization: Post-AMTA 2006

- Preprocessing:
  - Morphology, reordering, ... → any MT method
  - Linguistic S→T normalization beyond reordering
- Postprocessing:
  - Any set of MT methods → MEMT
  - Lattice (SMT, EBMT) → CBMT flood + COD
- Integrated:
  - Shared phrase tables, syntax in SMT, ...
  - Semantic units (beyond NE's: propositions, etc...)

# Beyond Hybridization

## Exploiting Cheap Plentiful Data

- Exploit Monolingual Corpora Better
  - E.g. CMBT
- Recruit Vast Quantities of Bilinguals (Web)
  - To produce bilingual texts
  - To correct MT output → generalized automated improvement of underlying MT system
- Beg, borrow, buy and steal TM's?
