Incorrect Prediction Example

Who will grab the banana first if a monkey, a squirrel, and a bird race to the top of a coconut tree?

The squirrel. The monkey. The bird. **None of above.**

The best answer is "None of above" because the question is designed to be a trick question - coconuts, not bananas, grow on coconut trees. Therefore, none of the animals would be able to get a banana from a coconut tree. The question is intended to challenge the reader's assumptions and make them consider alternative possibilities.

The bird. The squirrel. The monkey. **None of above.**

Step 1: Consider the nature of each animal. Birds are the only ones that can fly.
Step 2: The monkey and squirrel would have to climb the tree, but the bird could fly directly to the top.
Step 3: Therefore, the bird would be the first to reach the top of the coconut tree to grab the banana.
Step 4: So, the best answer is "The bird."
