Language Research at DARPA - Machine Translation and Beyond

Dr. Bonnie J. Dorr joined DARPA as a program manager in 2011 and oversees programs that are a part of the Agency's investment in human language technology. Her research interests are in the area of computational linguistics, specifically machine translation, summarization, dialogue, and semantically informed language understanding and generation. Dr. Dorr is on assignment from the University of Maryland, where she holds a full professorship in the Department of Computer Science and at the Institute for Advanced Computer Studies. She was formerly associate dean for the College of Computer, Mathematical, and Natural Sciences and served for 15 years as co-director of the Computational Linguistics and Information Processing Laboratory. She holds a Doctor of Philosophy in Computer Science from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology.
